Aims of the Workshop

The aims of this course are to provide delegates with the knowledge and skills required to conduct suitable and sufficient fire risk assessments and to identify appropriate preventive and protective measures in most workplaces.

The workshop is designed to promote interaction between both the presenter and delegates and involves several syndicate exercises

Objectives

At the end of this course, delegates will be able to:

- Use a simple fire risk assessment technique to identify fire hazards, determine risk levels, to assess the adequacy of existing controls, and to identify areas or circumstances where additional controls may be required, and to:
- Identify typical causes of fire and explosion in work premises / activities
- Outline the principles of ignition, and the spread of fire, in work premises
- Outline appropriate preventive and protective measures to minimise fire risks
- Outline the methods and systems available to give early warning in case of fire
- Advise on the requirements for storage facilities for flammable materials
- Identify and minimise risks from arson
- Advise on fire evacuation procedures and appropriate means of escape
- Advise on the selection of basic fire extinguishing methods

Who should attend?

The workshop is aimed at those with responsibilities for, or duties in relation to, fire safety in non-domestic premises.

- Managing Fire Safely:
 - The moral, legal and economic arguments for effective standards of fire safety
 - A framework for fire safety management
 - Emergency evacuation procedures
 - Investigating fires
- Principles of fire and explosion:
 - The fire triangle
 - Combustion and ignition
 - Classification of fires
 - Fire growth and spread
 - Explosion
- Causes and prevention of fires:
 - Common sources of ignition
 - Arson
 - Fire prevention strategies
- Fire protection in buildings:
 - Construction and design
 - Means of escape
 - Fire detection and alarm
 - Fire fighting
- Fire risk assessment:
 - Hazard and risk
 - Identifying fire hazards
 - Identifying populations at risk
 - Evaluating fire risks and existing controls
 - Developing action plans to control and reduce risk
 - Recording and reviewing the assessment
- Practical fire risk assessment exercise, walk through assessment, full report, recommendations & actions
